
Enci Grove walk





Can you believe that these amazing photos were taken in our beautiful Maastricht? Leave the city centre for a walk in the Dutch countryside and also take in the unusual sight of the disused Enci quarry.



If you climb the Pietersberg hill from Luikerweg, pass the Chalet Bergrust and keep walking straight up, up, up. Make sure that you take a moment to turn round and observe the stunning views of Maastricht. Eventually, if you stick to the path, you will reach the viewing platform that overlooks the Enci quarry (there are even binoculars if you wish to take a closer look).

Walk down the stairs and keep walking the loop. There are always interesting species to look out for in the crystal blue waters then by the gates that exit the Enci area,

there is usually a food/drink truck to refresh you for the final stretch. If you stick to the loop, up again, through the trees, you'll come very close to the Belgium border, stick to the Dutch side for some beautiful views of Kanne and the stunning Chateau Nercanne. The home stretch is through a tunnel of green trees and you end where you began.
